## 7. Organisation of future work

<u>The Presidency</u> informed the SCA about the "Agriculture and Fisheries" Council meeting on 20 November 2023.

As regards that Council meeting,

- <u>the Italian delegation</u> requested an item under "any other business" on the Role of farmers in ensuring sustainability in rural areas, to be held in public session;
- the French delegation requested an item under "any other business" on a partial application of Good Agricultural and Environmental Condition (GAEC) no. 8 for the 2024 campaign; to be held in public session.
- <u>The SCA</u> subsequently agreed that these two items would be held in public session in accordance with article 8(2) of the rules of procedure of the Council.
- Futhermore, the German delegation informed the SCA about an item under "any other business" on support measures for partner countries within the EU Regulation on deforestation-free supply chains, which would be requested at COREPER.

<u>The Presidency</u> also informed the SCA that the December "Agriculture and Fisheries" Council meeting would take place on Sunday 10 and Monday 11 December.
