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Subject: Prolongation of temporary reintroduction of border controls at the Polish internal borders with Czechia, Slovakia, Germany and Lithuania in accordance with Article 28(3) and pursuant to Article 27 of Regulation (EU) 2016/399 on a Union Code on the rules governing the movement of persons across borders (Schengen Borders Code)

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Delegations will find attached a copy of a letter received by the General Secretariat of the Council on 24 March 2020 regarding the prolongation of the temporary reintroduction of border controls by Poland at the internal borders with Czechia, Slovakia, Germany and Lithuania between 25 March 2020 and 13 April 2020.

Warszawa, dnia 24 marca 2020 r.

*Szanowni Państwo,*

w związku z utrzymywaniem się poważnego zagrożenia dla zdrowia publicznego wywołanego koronawirusem SARS-CoV-2 (choroba COVID-19) i koniecznością zapewnienia bezpieczeństwa wewnętrznego i porządku publicznego, zgodnie z art. 28 ust. 3, w trybie art. 27 rozporządzenia Parlamentu Europejskiego i Rady (UE) 2016/399 z dnia 9 marca 2016 r. w sprawie unijnego kodeksu zasad regulujących przepływ osób przez granicę (kodeks graniczny Schengen), mając na celu przeciwdziałanie rozprzestrzenianiu się koronawirusa, a tym samym wjazdowi do Polski osób, które mogą stanowić poważne zagrożenie dla zdrowia publicznego, podjąłem decyzję o przedłużeniu kontroli granicznej na granicach wewnętrznych.

Kontrola graniczna zostanie przedłużona na okres od dnia 25 marca 2020 r. do dnia 13 kwietnia 2020 r. na odcinkach granicy państwowej z Republiką Czeską, Republiką Słowacką, Republiką Federalną Niemiec, Republiką Litewską oraz w morskich i lotniczych przejściach granicznych.

Zakres i intensywność kontroli granicznej pozostaną ograniczone do niezbędnych czynności w celu zapewnienia porządku publicznego i bezpieczeństwa wewnętrznego. Kontrole graniczne będą realizowane na podstawie analizy ryzyka, w sposób elastyczny w odniesieniu do miejsca i czasu.

Przekraczanie wewnętrznej granicy Polski będzie dozwolone w wyznaczonych miejscach, zgodnie z listą zamieszczoną w załączniku.

Due to the serious threat to public health related to the spread of the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus (responsible for COVID-19 disease) and the need to ensure internal security and public order, in accordance with Article 28(3) and pursuant to Article 27 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/399 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 March 2016 on a Union Code on the rules governing the movement of persons across borders (Schengen Borders Code), with a view to preventing the spread of the coronavirus and thus the entry to Poland of people who could pose a serious threat to public health, I have made a decision to extend border control at internal borders.

Border control is to be extended for the period from 25 March 2020 to 13 April 2020 at the sections of the Polish border with the Czech Republic, the Slovak Republic, the Federal Republic of Germany, the Republic of Lithuania as well as at sea and air border crossing points.

The scope and intensity of border control will be limited to activities necessary to ensure public order and internal security. Border control will be carried out on the basis of risk analysis and in a manner that is flexible in order to accommodate time and location considerations.

Crossing the internal border of Poland will be permitted at authorised crossing points, as indicated in the list provided in the Annex.
