Policy debate

The Council held a policy debate on the above subject on the basis of a discussion paper prepared by the Presidency. The recent European Parliament legislative initiative (Art. 225 TFEU) inviting the Commission to table proposals for an EU legal framework in this area provided the political context for this debate. Ministers presented their national measures to ensure adequate working conditions, gender equality, and mobility in cultural and creative sectors. In this context, Ministers supported exchanges of best practices, an EU-wide definition of artists and creators, common databases, border transfer of labour rights, and a potential institutional framework establishing a European status of artists.
