Dear Secretary-General,

I would kindly ask you to initiate the appointment procedure laid down in Article 305 TFEU for the following new nomination to the Committee of the Regions (CoR).

The Free State of Bavaria has nominated Eric Beißwenger, Staatsminister für Europaangelegenheiten und Internationales (Minister for European and International Affairs), as new full member of the CoR for the seventh term of office. The new nomination was necessary owing to the departure of his predecessor, Staatsministerin (Minister of State) Ms Melanie Huml.

The Federal Government hereby proposes that Staatsminister (Minister State) Mr Eric Beißwenger be appointed as a member of the CoR for the seventh term of office.
