Subject: Approval of the election of a vice-president of Eurojust

Under Article 28 of the Council Decision setting up Eurojust<sup>1</sup>, the College of Eurojust may, if it considers it necessary, elect one or two vice-presidents. The result of the election has to be submitted to the Council for approval.

By letter of 5 November 2019, set out in the <u>Annex</u> to this note, Eurojust informed the General Secretariat of the Council that earlier that day it elected Mr Klaus Meyer-Cabri, national member for Germany, as one of its two vice-presidents.

Subject to agreement by Coreper, the Council is invited to approve the election of Mr Meyer-Cabri as vice-president of Eurojust.
