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1. In accordance with the relevant establishing acts and, as regards the European Joint Undertaking for ITER and the Development of Fusion Energy, also in accordance with Article 70(4) of Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2018/1046<sup>1</sup>, the Council is required to draw up recommendations to the European Parliament on a discharge to be given to the joint undertakings.

2. At its meetings on 12 and 22 January 2024, the Budget Committee examined the nine specific annual reports<sup>2</sup> of the European Court of Auditors related to joint undertakings, and reached an agreement on the draft texts as set out in the Addendum.
3. The Budget Committee advises the Permanent Representatives Committee to suggest that the Council:
  - adopt the draft recommendations as set out in the Addendum to this note; and
  - arrange for them to be forwarded to the European Parliament and approve the draft letter in the Annex to that effect.
