Subject: COUNCIL DECISION on the existence of an excessive deficit in Romania (ST 6304/20), and
COUNCIL Recommendation with a view to bringing an end to the situation of an excessive government deficit in Romania (ST 6305/20)
– Outcome of the written procedure initiated by CM 1867/20

Delegations are informed that the written procedure, opened by CM 1867/20 of 1 April 2020, was completed on 3 April 2020 and that all delegations voted in favour of:

1. the adoption of the COUNCIL DECISION on the existence of an excessive deficit in Romania, as set out in document 6304/20;
2. the adoption of the COUNCIL Recommendation with a view to bringing an end to the situation of an excessive government deficit in Romania, as set out in document ST 6305/20.

The required qualified majority, excluding the Member State in question, has been reached in both acts. Therefore, the above acts of the Council are adopted.

With the agreement of the Member State in question, and in line with usual practice as laid down in the Resolution of the European Council on the Stability and Growth Pact of 17 June 1997 (97/C 236/01), the Council Recommendation as set out in document 6305/20 will be made public.
