Subject:	Attendance of EIGE at the Social Questions Working Party on 29 February 2024

The European Institute for Gender Equality (EIGE) is preparing a study entitled "Financial independence and gender equality in the EU", which will serve as important background for a set of draft Council Conclusions on "Economic empowerment and financial independence of women as a pathway to substantive gender equality" prepared by the Presidency.

On 29 February 2024, the Presidency intends to organise a meeting of the Social Questions Working Party to discuss the draft Conclusions. The Presidency intends to invite EIGE to present its report at the beginning of this meeting, before the Working Party begins its deliberations.
