Subject:	Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers Appointment of Ms Magdalena CHOJNOWSKA, member for Poland, in place of Ms Magdalena KOSSAKOWSKA, who has resigned

1. The General Secretariat of the Council has been informed of the resignation of Ms Magdalena KOSSAKOWSKA as member of the above Committee in the trade unions' representatives category (for Poland).
2. Under Article 24 of Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union¹, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union³, and in particular Articles 23 and 24 thereof.

Whereas:

- (1) By its Decision of 20 September 2022⁴, the Council appointed members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for the period ending on 24 September 2024.
- (2) A seat as member in the trade unions' representatives category has fallen vacant as a result of the resignation of Ms Magdalena KOSSAKOWSKA.
- (3) The government of Poland has submitted a nomination for the vacant seat,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:
