Subject: Draft DIRECTIVE OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on a single application procedure for a single permit for third-country nationals to reside and work in the territory of a Member State and on a common set of rights for third-country workers legally residing in a Member State (recast) **(first reading)**
- Adoption of the legislative act

1. On 28 April 2022 the Commission submitted its proposal¹, based on Article 79(2) points (a) and (b) TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 26 October 2022².
3. The European Committee of the Regions delivered its opinion on 30 November 2022³.
4. On 13 March 2024 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council⁴.

5. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council⁵ ⁶ approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 93/23, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with Hungary and Finland voting against and the Czech Republic, Estonia and Croatia abstaining.
6. The statement for the minutes of the Council meeting is set out in the Addendum to this note.
7. If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
