With a view to the Council ('Agriculture and Fisheries') on 29 April 2024, delegations will find in the annex a note from the Presidency containing questions to frame the exchange of views on the above-mentioned subject.

Follow-up to the Commission performance report of the CAP

The Common Agricultural Policy (CAP) Annual Performance Report gives an overview of the performance of the CAP implemented in the Member States. The report highlights the role of CAP strategic plans in safeguarding farmers' incomes and food security, while supporting the transition to a sustainable agricultural model. It is based on a set of indicators, assessments and experiences drawn from the Performance Monitoring and Evaluation Framework (PMEF). The report also contributes to the debate on future policy developments.

Based on the document presented by the Commission (doc. 8794/24), the Presidency invites delegations to answer the following questions to frame the exchange of views.

Taking account of the fact that the performance reports only cover the first year of implementation and therefore results of the new policy are not yet fully developed,

- 1. Do you think that the measures taken in the CAP strategic plan have made it possible to meet the expectations as set out in the intervention logic of your CAP strategic plan? How do you expect those to evolve in the near future in order to meet your milestones and targets?*
 - 2. Are there particular experiences from the drawing up of the first CAP strategic plan Annual Performance Report as regards the new delivery model which you would like to share ?*
