Objet:	Conséquences de la guerre d'agression de la Russie sur le secteur sportif ukrainien <i>- Informations communiquées par la présidence</i>

La présidence a inscrit à l'ordre du jour un point divers sur les conséquences de la guerre d'agression russe contre l'Ukraine sur son secteur sportif. La présidence a invité le ministre ukrainien de la jeunesse et des sports par intérim et le ministre ukrainien adjoint de la jeunesse et des sports à être présents pour ce point divers. Il est prévu que le ministre ukrainien de la jeunesse et des sports par intérim intervienne sur les points présentés en annexe.

**Expected main points of the intervention of Acting Minister for Youth and Sports of Ukraine
at the meeting of the EYCS Council (Sport)**

- The situation in Ukraine in light of Russia's war of aggression; the impact of the war on the sport sector in Ukraine.
- Current situation on losses of athletes and coaches; damaged and destroyed sport facilities.
- Activities of the Ministry of Youth and Sports of Ukraine regarding the development and implementation of state policy in the field of physical culture and sports under the conditions of martial law.
- Measures of assistance to members of the national sports teams of Ukraine who have suffered from the aggression of the Russian federation against Ukraine.
- Measures that are taken by Ukraine to oppose the participation of Russian and Belarusian athletes in international competitions.
- The experience of Ukraine in the rehabilitation of military personnel and civilians injured as a result of Russian aggression, through the means of sports and physical culture.
- Preparation of Ukrainian national teams for participation in the Paris 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games.
- Proposals on joint initiatives and projects with EU Member States aimed at supporting the sphere of physical culture and sports in Ukraine both during the war and in the context of post-war reconstruction, including the reconstruction of sports infrastructure.
