With reference to the composition of the Italian delegation at the European Committee of the Regions, I would like to inform you that the Conference of Presidents of the Legislative Assemblies of the Regions and Autonomous Provinces has nominated the following members:

- as **member**, Gaetano Galvagno, Presidente dell'Assemblea Regionale Siciliana (President of the Sicilian Regional Assembly), to replace Alessandro Fermi, former President of the Lombardy Regional Council, who no longer holds office;
