Subject:	Council Decision appointing a member, proposed by Ireland, of the Committee of the Regions
	- Adoption

1. By letter of 20 December 2023¹, the Secretary-General of the Committee of the Regions notified the Council of the resignation of Mr Eamon DOOLEY, member of the Committee of the Regions.
2. Under Article 305 TFEU, the Council appoints members and alternate members of the Committee of the Regions, acting by a qualified majority on proposals by the respective Member States.
3. In accordance with that provision and for the purpose of the replacement of Mr Eamon DOOLEY, the Government of Ireland has proposed² Mr Mick CAHILL, representative of a local body who holds a local authority electoral mandate, *Councillor of Longford County Council*, as a member of the Committee of the Regions for the remainder of the current term of office, which runs until 25 January 2025.
