Subject:	Council Decision appointing a member, proposed by Ireland, of the Committee of the Regions
	- Adoption

- 1. By letter of 20 December 2023¹, the Secretary-General of the Committee of the Regions notified the Council of the resignation of Mr Eamon DOOLEY, member of the Committee of the Regions.
- 2. Under Article 305 TFEU, the Council appoints members and alternate members of the Committee of the Regions, acting by a qualified majority on proposals by the respective Member States.
- 3. In accordance with that provision and for the purpose of the replacement of Mr Eamon DOOLEY, the Government of Ireland has proposed² Mr Mick CAHILL, representative of a local body who holds a local authority electoral mandate, *Councillor of Longford County Council*, as a member of the Committee of the Regions for the remainder of the current term of office, which runs until 25 January 2025.
