| | - Adoption of the legislative act |

- 1. On 13 July 2016 the Commission submitted its proposal¹, based on Article 78(2), points (d) and (g) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The <u>European Economic and Social Committee</u> delivered its opinion on 25 January 2017².
- 3. The Committee of the Regions delivered its opinion on 8 February 2017³.
- On 10 April 2024 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the 4. Commission proposal⁴. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council.

- 5. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u>⁵ approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in <u>PE-CONS 18/24</u>, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with <u>Poland</u> and <u>Hungary</u> voting against and the <u>Czech Republic</u> and <u>Slovakia</u> abstaining.
- 6. The statements for the minutes of the Council meeting are set out in the <u>Addendum</u> to this note.
- 7. If the <u>Council</u> approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

In accordance with Articles 1 and 2 of the Protocol (No 22) on the position of Denmark, annexed to the TEU and to the TFEU, Denmark is not taking part in the adoption of this Regulation and is not bound by it or subject to its application.

In accordance with Articles 1 and 2 and Article 4a(1) of Protocol No 21 on the position of the United Kingdom and Ireland in respect of the area of freedom, security and justice, annexed to the TEU and to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union (TFEU), and without prejudice to Article 4 of that Protocol, Ireland is not taking part in the adoption of this Regulation and is not bound by it or subject to its application.
