## **'I/A' ITEM NOTE**

To:	Permanent Representatives Committee/Council
Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on standards for the qualification of third-country nationals or stateless persons as beneficiaries of international protection, for a uniform status for refugees or for persons eligible for subsidiary protection and for the content of the protection granted, amending Council Directive 2003/109/EC and repealing Directive 2011/95/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council (first reading)  - Adoption of the legislative act

- 1. On 13 July 2016 the <u>Commission</u> submitted its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 78(2), points (a) and (b), and Article 79(2), point (a) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The <u>European Economic and Social Committee</u> delivered its opinion on 14 December 2016<sup>2</sup>.
- 3. The <u>Committee of the Regions</u> delivered its opinion on 8 February 2017<sup>3</sup>.
- 4. On 10 April 2024 the <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal<sup>4</sup>. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council.

- 5. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u><sup>5</sup> approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in <u>PE-CONS 70/23</u>, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with <u>Hungary</u> and <u>Poland</u> voting against and <u>Austria</u>, the <u>Czech Republic</u> and <u>Slovakia</u> abstaining.
- 6. The statements for the minutes of the Council meeting are set out in the <u>Addendum</u> to this note.
- 7. If the <u>Council</u> approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
