Subject:	Council Decision appointing two alternate members, proposed by the Federal Republic of Germany, of the Committee of the Regions
	- Adoption

- 1. By letters of 7 December 2023<sup>1</sup> and 19 December 2023<sup>2</sup>, the Secretary-General of the Committee of the Regions notified the Council of the resignation of Mr Josef FREY, alternate member of the Committee of the Regions, and of the end of mandate on the basis of which Ms Heike SCHARFENBERGER, alternate member of the Committee of the Regions, was proposed for appointment and appointed.
- 2. Under Article 305 TFEU, the Council appoints members and alternate members of the Committee of the Regions, acting by a qualified majority on proposals by the respective Member States.
- 3. In accordance with that provision and for the purpose of their replacement, the German Government has proposed<sup>3</sup> Mr Niklas NÜSSLE, *Mitglied des Landtages von Baden-Württemberg* (Member of the State Parliament of Baden-Württemberg), and Mr Gregory SCHOLZ, *Mitglied des Landtages von Rheinland-Pfalz* (Member of the State Parliament of Rhineland-Palatinate), representatives of regional bodies who hold a regional authority
