Subject:	Council Decision appointing a member and an alternate member, proposed by the Republic of Estonia, of the Committee of the Regions
	- Adoption

1. By letters of 19 April 2024¹ and 3 May 2024², the Secretary-General of the Committee of the Regions notified the Council of the end of the mandates on the basis of which Mr Jevgeni OSSINOVSKI, member of the Committee of the Regions, and Mr Tiit TERIK alternate member of the Committee of the Regions were proposed for appointment and appointed.
2. Under Article 305 TFEU, the Council appoints members and alternate members of the Committee of the Regions, acting by a qualified majority on proposals by the respective Member States.

3. In accordance with that provision and for the purpose of the replacement of Mr Jevgeni OSSINOVSKI, the Estonian Government has proposed³ Mr Jevgeni OSSINOVSKI, representative of a local body who is politically accountable to an elected assembly, *Tallina linnapea* (Mayor of Tallinn City), as a member of the Committee of the Regions, on the basis of a different national mandate, for the remainder of the current term of office, which runs until 25 January 2025.
4. For the purpose of the replacement of Mr Tiit TERIK, the Estonian Government has proposed³ Mr Tiit TERIK representative of a local body who holds a local authority electoral mandate, *Tallina Linnavolikogu liige* (Member of Tallinn City Council), as an alternate member of the Committee of the Regions, on the basis of a different national mandate, for the remainder of the current term of office, which runs until 25 January 2025.
5. In view of the above, the Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore invited to confirm its agreement on the text of the Decision set out in document 10416/24 and to suggest that the Council adopt that Decision as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting.
