I. INTRODUCTION

The rapporteur, Laura BALLARÍN CEREZA (S&D, ES), presented a report on behalf of the Committee on the Internal Market and Consumer Protection (IMCO), aiming at taking over the above proposal for a Regulation.

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the Commission proposal to Parliament and the Council (COM(2023)0647),
 - having regard to Article 294(2) and Article 114 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, pursuant to which the Commission submitted the proposal to Parliament (C9-0380/2023),
 - having regard to Article 294(3) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,
 - having regard to the opinion of the European Economic and Social Committee of 14 February 2024¹,
 - having regard to Rule 59 of its Rules of Procedure,
 - having regard to the report of the Committee on the Internal Market and Consumer Protection (A9-0058/2024),
1. Adopts its position at first reading, taking over the Commission proposal;
 2. Calls on the Commission to refer the matter to Parliament again if it replaces, substantially amends or intends to substantially amend its proposal;
 3. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council, the Commission and the national parliaments.
