#### d) Detailed grounds for the decrease

Under Article 9(1)(a) of Council Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2020/2093 laying down the multiannual financial framework for the years 2021 to 2027, as amended by Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2024/765 of 29 February 2024, the "European Solidarity Reserve" is intended to provide "assistance to respond to emergency situations resulting from major disasters that are covered by the European Union Solidarity Fund, the objectives and scope of which are set out in Council Regulation (EC) No 2012/2002".

Point 10 of the Interinstitutional Agreement of 16 December 2020 between the European Parliament, the Council of the European Union and the European Commission on budgetary discipline, on cooperation on budgetary matters and on sound financial management, as well as on new own resources, including a roadmap towards the introduction of new own resources (IIA), lays down the modalities for the mobilisation of the European Union Solidarity Fund (EUSF) in the context of the Solidarity and Emergency Aid Reserve (SEAR).

#### d) Detailed grounds for the increase

The transfer of EUR 796 760 300 is necessary in order to cover the payment needs arising from the Commission's proposal to mobilise financial contribution from the European Union Solidarity Fund (EUSF) for the applications in response to natural disasters which occurred in 2023 and presented by Italy (floods in the Emilia-Romagna and Tuscany regions), Slovenia, Austria, Greece and France. The total amount of the EUSF support for the above-mentioned Member States is EUR 1 028 541 689.

In addition to the appropriations to be transferred from the European Solidarity Reserve line, this mobilisation is proposed to be financed through the use of the amount of EUR 37 073 004 in commitment and payment appropriations already inscribed in the General Budget 2024 and EUR 194 708 385 from appropriations of the General Budget 2023, which have already been paid as advances, in accordance with Article 4a of the EUSF Regulation.
