Subject:	Council approval for the opening of negotiations between the Commission and the Republic of China on a non-binding EU-China Joint Roadmap for Future Science, Technology and Innovation Cooperation
	- Approval of entering into negotiations
	- Decision to use the written procedure

- 1. On 21 April 2020, the Working Party on Research received information from the Commission on its intention to enter into negotiations on a non-binding EU-China Joint Roadmap for Future Science, Technology and Innovation Cooperation. This Joint Roadmap is expected to include a list of discussion points for framework conditions for a level playing field in R&I such as intellectual property rights, reciprocal access to R&I programmes, open access and mobility of researchers as well as thematic areas in support of climate, environmental and health challenges.
- 2. It is understood that the <u>Commission</u> will revert to the <u>Council</u> at the end of the negotiations to seek approval by the <u>Council</u> for the signature of the EU-China Joint Roadmap on behalf of the Union.

- 3. In view of the above, the <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is invited:
 - to confirm its approval for the <u>Commission</u> to enter into negotiations on the EU-China
 Joint Roadmap for Future Science, Technology and Innovation Cooperation, and
 - to decide, in accordance with the first subparagraph of Article 12(1) of the Council's
 Rules of Procedure and Article 1 of Council Decision 2020/430, that the Council uses
 the written procedure for the approval to enter into negotiations.
