Subject:	Advisory Committee on Safety and Health at Work Appointment of Mr Thomas VOIGTLÄNDER, member for Germany, in place of Mr Kai SCHÄFER, who has resigned

---

1. The General Secretariat of the Council has been informed of the resignation of Mr Kai SCHÄFER, as member of the above Committee in the governments' representatives category (for Germany).
2. Under Article 3 of Council Decision of 22 July 2003 setting up an Advisory Committee on Safety and Health at Work<sup>1</sup>, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council.

3. In accordance with the usual procedure, the Government of Germany has nominated Mr Thomas VOIGTLÄNDER for this seat for the remainder of the current term of office, ending on 28 February 2025.
4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to advise the Council to:
  - (a) adopt, as an "A" item, the Council Decision replacing an alternate member of the Advisory Committee on Safety and Health at Work, as set out in doc. 13121/24, and
  - (b) have the Decision published, for information, in the Official Journal of the European Union.
