Subject:	COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 26.7.2024 supplementing Regulation (EU) 2020/1056 by establishing the eFTI common data set and eFTI data subsets - Decision to request an extension of the time-limit to raise objections

1. The Commission notified the above delegated regulation to the Council on 26 July 2024 in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU, and with Articles 7 and 14 of Regulation (EU) 2020/1056¹.
2. In accordance with Article 14 of Regulation (EU) 2020/1056, the Council has two months to object to it, i.e. until 26 September 2024. That period for expressing an objection can be prolonged by further two months.
3. At the Intermodal Transport Working Party of 10 September 2024, several delegations indicated that given that the Council's scrutiny period overlapped with the summer holiday period, they would need additional time to assess the delegated regulation and consequently, they requested an extension of the deadline to raise objections.

4. This request was supported by the Working Party.
 5. In the light of the above, it is suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee invite the Council to decide to extend the time-limit for raising objections to the delegated regulation by two months, in accordance with Article 14 of Regulation (EU) 2020/1056.
 6. The Commission and the European Parliament will be informed thereof.
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
