<ul> <li>Decision to derogate from the 8-week period provided for in Article 4 of Protocol 1 to the TFEU on the role of national parliaments in the EU</li> </ul>	

- 1. On 29 April 2020 the <u>Commission</u> sent its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 100(2) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The <u>European Economic and Social Committee</u> has been consulted and is set to reply shortly.
- 3. The Committee of the Regions has been consulted and is set to reply shortly.
- 4. The <u>European Parliament</u> will adopt its position at first reading on the Commission proposal at its plenary on 13-16 May 2020.

- 5. Given the urgency entailed by the exceptional circumstances justifying the proposed measures, it will only be possible to adopt the Regulation via the written procedure.
- 6. In view of the above, the <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is invited to decide, in accordance with the first subparagraph of Article 12(1) of the Council's Rules of Procedure and Article 1 of Council Decision 2020/556<sup>2</sup>, that the Council uses the written procedure:
  - for the adoption of the draft Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Regulation (EC) N° 1008/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council on common rules for the operation of air services in the Community in view of the COVID-19 pandemic, as set out in document PE- CONS 13/20<sup>3</sup>; and
  - to derogate, on the basis of the second subparagraph of Article 3(3) of the Council's Rules of Procedure, from the eight-week period referred to in the first subparagraph of that Article.

Council Decision (EU) 2020/556 of 21 April 2020 extending the temporary derogation from the Council's Rules of Procedure introduced by Decision (EU) 2020/430 in view of the travel difficulties caused by the COVID-19 pandemic in the Union (OJ L 128I, 23.4.2020, p. 1).
