Subject: Special meeting of the European Council (17, 18, 19, 20 and 21 July 2020)

At its meeting on 17 October 2024, the European Council approved the minutes of its meeting on 17, 18, 19, 20 and 21 July 2020, as set out in this document, and decided to make them public.

1. Exchange of views with the President of the European Parliament

The President of the European Parliament was heard by the European Council.

2. Adoption of the agenda

The European Council adopted its agenda as set out in document EUCO 3/20.

3. European Semester 2020: country-specific recommendations and recommendation on the economic policy of the euro area

The European Council discussed a conclusion on the country-specific recommendations and the recommendation on the economic policy of the euro area for 2020.

4. Multiannual Financial Framework 2021-2027 and Recovery Package

The European Council reached agreement on the Multiannual Financial Framework 2021-2027 and the Recovery Package as set out in the conclusions. The European Council was presented with an opinion of the Legal Counsel on paragraph A19 of the conclusions (doc. EUCO 12/20).

Germany asked during the meeting to introduce to the minutes a statement on the correction of the German contribution. Germany explained that the fact that Germany was not asking for an increase of its contribution does not mean that it will not ask for one in the future. The statement to the minutes was not communicated during the meeting nor was it read. The president concluded the meeting. The statement was transmitted to the General Secretariat shortly after the end of the European Council meeting.

5. Adoption of the conclusions

The European Council adopted the conclusions, reflecting the outcome of its discussions, as set out in document EUCO 10/20.
