1. Exchange of views with the President of Ukraine

The European Council held an informal exchange of views with the President of Ukraine, Volodymyr ZELENSKYY.

2. Exchange of views with the President of the European Parliament

The President of the European Parliament was heard by the European Council.

3. Adoption of the agenda

The European Council adopted its agenda as set out in document EUCO 2/23.

4. Ukraine

The European Council discussed the Russian war of aggression against Ukraine and the European Union's continued support to Ukraine and its people.

The Polish member of the European Council raised the issue of the recognition of the Holodomor as genocide.

5. Economy

The European Council discussed the need to strengthen the European Union's strategic sovereignty, make its economic, industrial and technological base fit for the green and digital transitions, and to deepen the Single Market and ensure a level playing field both internally and globally. It will discuss at its next meeting how to enhance its long-term competitiveness and productivity, harnessing the full potential of the Single Market.

6. Migration

The European Council discussed the migration situation. It called on the Council and the Commission to closely monitor and ensure the implementation of its conclusions, and will revert to the matter on a regular basis.

7. Other items

The European Council discussed the earthquake that struck Türkiye and Syria on 6 February 2023 and the assistance provided by the European Union. It also discussed the Belgrade-Pristina Dialogue.

8. Adoption of the conclusions

The European Council adopted the conclusions, reflecting the outcome of its discussions, as set out in document EUCO 1/23.
