Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL laying down harmonised rules for the marketing of construction products and repealing Regulation (EU) No 305/2011 (first reading) - Adoption of the legislative act

1. On 30 March 2022 the Commission submitted its proposal¹, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 27 October 2022².
3. On 10 April 2024 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal (without legal linguistic revision). After finalisation of the adopted text by the legal linguists, the European Parliament approved a corrigendum to that position at its plenary session of 7 to 10 October 2024. It reflects the compromise agreement reached between the Institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council³.

4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 12/24, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with Bulgaria abstaining.
5. The statements for the minutes of the Council meeting are set out in the Addendum to this note.
6. If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
