Subject:	END OF WRITTEN PROCEDURE Council Decision authorising the opening of negotiations with New Zealand for an agreement between the European Union and New Zealand on the exchange of personal data between the European Union Agency for Law Enforcement Cooperation (Europol) and the New Zealand authorities competent for fighting serious crime and terrorism – Adoption

Delegations are informed that the written procedure, opened by CM 2124/20 of 30 April 2020 was completed on 13 May 2020 at 17:00 and that all delegations voted in favour of the adoption of the Council Decision authorising the opening of negotiations with New Zealand for an agreement between the European Union and New Zealand on the exchange of personal data between the European Union Agency for Law Enforcement Cooperation (Europol) and the New Zealand authorities competent for fighting serious crime and terrorism, as set out in ST 7047/20 + ADD 1.

The required qualified majority has been reached. Therefore, the above Council Decision is adopted.

The European Parliament will be informed of the outcome of this written procedure, in accordance with Article 218(10) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union.
