	- Decision to use the written procedure for adoption

- The presentation of the European Court of Auditors' Special Report No 15/2019: "Implementation of the 2014 staff reform package at the Commission - Big savings but not without consequences for staff"¹ took place in the Working Party on Staff Regulations meeting on 8 October 2019.
- The Working Party on Staff Regulations started with the examination of the draft Council conclusions during the Finnish Presidency².
- Further exchanges on the text continued during the Croatian Presidency³. After the meeting on 3 March 2020 and due to the COVID-19 pandemic, a series of informal written consultations between the Presidency and groups of delegations were organised.
