 The <u>Commission</u> submitted to the Council the proposal for the above-mentioned Council Decision on 20 May 2020.

- 2. The <u>Working Party on Technical Harmonisation (Motor Vehicles)</u> received advance copies of the Commission proposal on 15 May 2020. Following its formal adoption by the Commission, the Working Party on Technical Harmonisation (Motor Vehicles) was consulted by e-mail from 25 to 29 May 2020. In the written consultation, delegations did not raise any objection to the text of the Commission proposal.

Following the decision of the Permanent Representatives Committee (Part 1) on 10 June 2020 to use the written procedure, please state whether you agree to the adoption of the Council Decision and the recommended EU position as set out, after finalisation by lawyer-linguists, in documents 8164/20 and 8471/20.
