Subject:	Proposal for a COUNCIL DECISION on the adoption of the 2020-2023 high flux reactor supplementary research programme at Petten to be implemented by the Joint Research Centre for the European Atomic Energy Community - Decision to use the written procedure

1. On 2 March 2019, the Commission submitted to the Council the proposal for a Council Decision on the adoption of the 2020-2023 High Flux Reactor supplementary research programme at Petten to be implemented by the Joint Research Centre for the European Atomic Energy Community¹. The current supplementary research programme² has expired on the 31 December 2019. This proposal for a Council Decision concerns a new four-year programme for the High Flux Reactor operation (2020-2023) based on research activities of the Nuclear Research and consultancy Group V.O.F - NRG (The Netherlands), and the Commissariat à l'énergie atomique et aux énergies alternatives - CEA (France).
2. Following the written consultations of the Joint Research/Atomic Questions Working Party between 11 and 20 May 2020, the Working Party has reached an agreement on this draft Decision.
