Subject: Summary of discussions

1. Adoption of the agenda

The agenda as set out in CM 4186/1/19 REV 1 was adopted.

2. Information from the Presidency

The CCWP took note of the information provided by the Presidency on documents and past and coming meetings relevant to the work of the CCWP, as set out in WK 10931/19.

3. Europol EPCC 2-3 October 2019 - debrief

The Presidency debriefed delegations about the discussions at EPCC which was held at Europol headquarters on 2-3 October.

4. State of play of the preparations for the joint meeting with the DUWP on the 4 November 2019

The Presidency briefly informed delegations on the preparations for the joint meeting with the DUWP which will be held in 4 November.

5. SIS/VIS and PNR questionnaire report

The Romanian delegation presented the results of the SIS/VIS and PNR questionnaires. Delegations were asked to submit any written comments by 18 October.

6. Customs control procedures at the Malaszewicze railroad border crossing point

The Polish delegation gave a presentation on the control procedures at the Malaszewicze railroad border crossing point.

7. Preparation of the 10th Action Plan (2020-2021) of the CCWP - Summary of the results of the questionnaire

The Presidency presented the state of play of the preparations of the 10th Action Plan and summarised the results of the questionnaire as set out in 12820/19. This was followed by an exchange of views. Delegations were asked to submit any written comments by 18 October.

8. The 2019 WHO recommendations on international scheduling of cannabis and cannabis-related substances - state of play

A representative of the Horizontal Drugs Group (HDG) gave a presentation on the 2019 WHO recommendations on international scheduling of cannabis and cannabis-related substances.

The Presidency provided information on the meeting with DG Taxud, DG Home and OLAF which was held on 17 September 2019.

The Dutch delegation raised the question whether the business case for Snake II has to be approved by the CCWP. This issue is being examined by the Council Legal Service.
