Subject: Standing Committee on Operational Cooperation on Internal Security
(COSI) - written proceedings

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, a certain number of files that were scheduled for discussion at the COSI meeting in May were processed by written proceedings under request for contributions CM 2142/1/20 REV 1, as follows:

1. Information from the Presidency

Delegations took note of the items concluded by COSI SG, as set out in WK 4616/20.

2. Counter- terrorism

2.1. Defining a procedure for entering information from third countries on suspected non-EU terrorists into the Schengen Information System (SIS)

Delegations provided comments on the outline of a process for entering information on suspected FTFs received from trusted third countries into the SIS, as set out in 7741/20.

The compilation of comments is found under WK 5865/1/20 REV 1.

Next steps are under consideration.

2.2. EU threat assessment in the field of counter terrorism: recommendations

COSI delegations have endorsed the recommendations to the EU threat assessment in the field of counterterrorism as set out in 7740/20.

3. Fighting drugs trafficking: set of strategic and operational measures

The revised text of the set of strategic and operational measures as set out in 7743/1/20 REV 1 takes into account the written comments received from delegations and includes further refinements upon suggestions by delegations. The document is thus considered endorsed by COSI delegations.

4. Customs contribution to internal security

– Opportunities for cooperation between EU Policy Cycle/EMPACT OAPs and the 10th CCWP Action Plan in order to achieve synergies

The revised text of the document as set out in 7664/1/20 REV 1 takes into account the written comments received from COSI delegations and includes further refinements upon suggestions by delegations. The document is thus considered endorsed by COSI delegations.

Delegations took note of the background papers set out WK 4652/20 and WK 4654/20.

– Frontex Risk Analysis for 2020

Delegations took note of the information communication by Frontex in relation to the Frontex risk analysis for 2020, as set out in WK 4617/20.
