Following the decision of the Permanent Representatives Committee (Part 1) on 24 June 2020 to use the written procedure (see note 8588/20), please state whether you agree to the adoption of the **Council Decision on the conclusion, on behalf of the Union and its Member States, of a Protocol amending the Euro-Mediterranean Aviation Agreement between the European Union and its Member States, of the one part and the government of the State of Israel, of the other part, to take account of the accession to the European Union of the Republic of Croatia**, as set out, after lawyer-linguistic revision, in document 12265/14, in all languages, including in Irish and that the European Parliament is informed thusly.

Please answer by "YES", "NO", or "ABSTAIN".

Any unilateral statements should be made at the same time as answering the question, except for those already made at Coreper.

The Council's decision, if adopted, will be published in the Official Journal in all languages, including in Irish, and the European Parliament will be informed about it in accordance with Article 218(10) TFEU.
