Subject: Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Regulation (EU) No 1303/2013 as regards the resources for the specific allocation for the Youth Employment Initiative **(first reading)**

- Decision to use the written procedure for the adoption of the legislative act
- Decision to derogate from the 8-week period provided for in Article 4 of Protocol 1 to the TFEU on the role of national parliaments in the EU

1. On 25 May 2020 the Commission sent its proposal¹, based on Article 177 TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee adopted its opinion on 10 June 2020².
3. The Committee of the Regions has been consulted and is set to reply shortly.
4. The European Parliament will adopt its position at first reading on the Commission proposal at its plenary on 8-10 July 2020.

5. Given the urgency entailed by the exceptional circumstances justifying the proposed measures, it will only be possible to adopt the Regulation by written procedure, within a very short deadline, as the act will be signed on 15 July 2020 and published shortly after.
6. In view of the above, the Permanent Representatives Committee is invited to decide, in accordance with the first subparagraph of Article 12(1) of the Council's Rules of Procedure and Article 1 of Council Decision 2020/702³, that the Council uses the written procedure:
- for the adoption of the draft Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Regulation (EU) No 1303/2013 as regards the resources for the specific allocation for the Youth Employment Initiative, as set out in document PE- CONS 22/20⁴, and
 - to derogate, on the basis of the second subparagraph of Article 3(3) of the Council's Rules of Procedure, from the eight-week period referred to in the first subparagraph of that Article.
