Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 6.7.2020 amending Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/592 on temporary exceptional measures derogating from certain provisions of Regulation (EU) No 1308/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council to address the market disturbance in the fruit and vegetables and wine sectors caused by the COVID-19 pandemic and measures linked to it
- Intention not to raise objection to a delegated act

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with Article 219(1) of Regulation (EU) No 1308/2013¹. The Commission having notified the delegated act on 6 July 2020, the Council may object to it until 7 September 2020.
2. On 13 July 2020, the Special Committee on Agriculture (SCA) confirmed the outcome of the silence consultation launched on 6 July by which delegations considered there were no grounds for the Council to object to the delegated act. The SCA also agreed to inform the Parliament and the Commission, prior to the expiry of the period for objecting.

3. Therefore the SCA suggests that the Council, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 227(5) of Regulation (EU) No 1308/2013.
