Italy has always requested the inclusion of GI's in the scope of the criminal enforcement section of the Agreement.

In a spirit of compromise, Italy proposes the following wording for Article 10.24.1 and Article 10.24.9 as in document 204/09.

Italy considers that the proposed text is flexible enough to accommodate the concerns raised by some Member States.

Article 10.24.1

1. This section lays down criminal provisions to ensure the enforcement of trademark, copyright and related rights (***and design and related rights***).

RESTREINT UE

2. Each party shall provide for criminal procedures and penalties to be applied in cases of wilful trademark (***and design and related rights***) counterfeiting and copyright and related rights piracy on a commercial scale.

Each party shall adopt measures as it may be necessary to establish the liability of physical and juridical persons for geographical indications counterfeiting. According to the general principles of the national legal system of the Party, the nature of the liability may be criminal or not criminal.

Article 10.24.9 "Rendez-vous clause"
