- *Designation of Working Party*

1. On 7 November 2019, the European Court of Auditors published Special Report No 19/2019 entitled "INEA: benefits delivered but CEF shortcomings to be addressed"<sup>1</sup>.
2. Under the rules laid down in the Council conclusions on improving the examination of special reports drawn up by the Court of Auditors<sup>2</sup>, it is suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee instruct the Working Party on Transport - Intermodal Questions and Networks to examine the report in accordance with those rules.
