Subject:	Draft Council conclusions on Special Report No 04/2020 from the European Court of Auditors entitled: "Using new imaging technologies to monitor the Common Agricultural Policy: steady progress overall, but slower for climate and environment monitoring" - Decision to use the written procedure for approval

1. The Permanent Representatives' Committee, at its meeting on 30 September 2020, endorsed the draft Council conclusions in response to the European Court of Auditors' Special Report No 04/2020 entitled: "Using new imaging technologies to monitor the Common Agricultural Policy: steady progress overall, but slower for climate and environment monitoring". The Committee also decided to recommend to the Council to approve the draft Council conclusions as an "A" item at one of its forthcoming meetings.

2. In light of the current exceptional circumstances, which make it impossible to approve "A" items at Council meetings in the coming weeks, the Permanent Representatives' Committee is invited to decide, in accordance with the first subparagraph of Article 12(1) of the Council's Rules of Procedure and Article 1 of Council Decision (EU) 2020/430¹, that the Council uses the written procedure for the approval of the draft Council conclusions.
