Subject: Commission Regulation (EU) .../... of XXX amending Annex XVII to Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) as regards substances in tattoo inks or permanent make-up
- Decision not to oppose adoption

1. On 17 July 2020, the Commission submitted the above draft Regulation to the Council, which amends Annex XVII of Regulation (EC) 1907/2006¹ in accordance with its Article 68(1) and Article 5a(3)(a)(d) of Council Decision 1999/468/EC². Pursuant to the said articles, if neither the European Parliament nor the Council have opposed the measures envisaged by the Commission, the draft Regulation shall be adopted by the Commission.

2. Article 131 of Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 provides that the Annexes of this Regulation may be amended in accordance with the procedure referred to in Article 133.
 3. On 16 July 2020, the Committee established under Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 voted in favour of the measure in the draft Regulation to amend Annex XVII of Regulation (EC) 1907/2006, in accordance with Article 5a(2) of Council Decision 1999/468/EC.
 4. On 20 July 2020, delegations were asked by 16 September 2020 to indicate their possible opposition to the draft Regulation. No delegation raised any relevant grounds for opposition.
 5. Against this background, the Permanent Representatives Committee is invited to recommend to the Council to confirm the non-opposition to the draft Regulation, as set out in document ST 9803/20 + ADD 1 as an item without discussion at one of its forthcoming meetings.
