Presentation by the Commission Exchange of views

<u>The Council</u> took note of the presentation provided by the Commission on the communication published in July 2019 on stepping up EU action to protect and restore the world's forests. <u>Delegations</u> held a policy debate on the basis of a background document prepared by the Presidency. <u>Ministers</u> welcomed the communication which contains five priorities and 36 key actions. Moreover they broadly supported the Presidency's plan to have Council Conclusions adopted on this topic before the end of 2019.

<u>The Council</u> held an exchange of views on the future of the Forest Strategy after 2020 on the basis of a background document prepared by the Presidency. <u>Ministers</u> strongly supported the preparation of a more robust framework to further enhance the coordination and coherence between the EU and Member States' forest related policies.
