Subject:	Draft Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council empowering France to negotiate an agreement supplementing its existing bilateral Treaty with the United Kingdom concerning the construction and operation by private concessionaires of a Channel Fixed Link (first reading) - Decision to use the written procedure for the adoption of the legislative act

1. On 27 July 2020 the Commission sent its proposal¹, based on Articles 2(1) and 91 TFEU, to the Council. On 14 September 2020 the Commission sent a corrigendum of its proposal, adding Article 2(1) TFEU as an additional legal base².
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 16 September 2020³.
3. The Committee of the Regions was consulted.
4. The European Parliament will adopt its position at first reading on the Commission proposal at its plenary on 5-8 October 2020.
