Subject: Draft Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on the quality of water intended for human consumption (recast) **(first reading)**
- Adoption of the Council's position at first reading and of the statement of the Council's reasons

1. On 1 February 2018 the Commission sent its proposal¹, based on Article 192(1) TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 11 July 2018².
3. The Committee of the Regions delivered its opinion on 16 May 2018³.
4. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on 28 March 2019⁴.

5. On 5 March 2020, the Council reached a political agreement on the Council's position at first reading on the above draft Directive⁵.
6. The Permanent Representatives Committee is asked to suggest that the Council:
 - adopt its position at first reading, as set out in document 6230/20 and the statement of reasons, as set out in document 6230/20 ADD 1, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting with Austria abstaining and Bulgaria voting against;
 - order that the statements in the addendum to this note be entered in the minutes of that meeting.
