## INTRODUCTION

1. On 28 September 2020, the <u>Commission</u> transmitted the above-mentioned proposal to the Council.

- 2. The proposal aims to amend Council Decision (EU) 2020/721<sup>1</sup> in order to add to that decision a Union position for the approval of an MSC-MEPC.5 circular on the Model agreement for the authorization of recognized organizations acting on behalf of the Administration. The circular is expected to be approved jointly by the International Maritime Organization's (IMO) Maritime Safety Committee at its 102nd session (MSC 102) from 4 to 11 November 2020 and the Marine Environment Protection Committee at its 75th session (MEPC 75) from 16 to 20 November 2020.
- The approval of the MSC-MEPC.5 circular would be capable of decisively influencing the content of Union law, namely Directive 2009/15/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council<sup>2</sup>.

## WORK WITHIN THE COUNCIL PREPARATORY BODIES

- The proposal was examined by the <u>Shipping Working Party</u> on 30 September and 7 October 2020. At the latter meeting, the working party agreed on the text.
- The <u>Commission</u> voiced concerns on some of the amendments made to its original proposal and announced its intention to make a statement to the minutes of the Permanent Representatives Committee and of the Council.
- 6. Following the agreement reached at working party level, the text of the draft Council Decision was revised by the Council's legal-linguistic services.
