Subject:	Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on the mobilisation of the European Union Solidarity Fund to provide assistance to Croatia and Poland in relation to a natural disaster and to provide for the payment of advances to Croatia, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Portugal and Spain in relation to a public health emergency

1. On 9 October 2020, the <u>Commission</u> forwarded to the Council a proposal for a Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on the mobilisation of the EU Solidarity Fund for a total amount of EUR 823.55 million in commitment and payment appropriations.

The objectives of this proposal are to provide financial assistance to Croatia (EUR 683.74 million) and Poland (EUR 7.07 million) in relation to natural disasters and to pay advances to Croatia (EUR 8.46 million), Germany (EUR 14.50 million), Greece (EUR 4.54 million), Hungary (EUR 26.59 million), Ireland (EUR 23.28 million), Portugal (EUR 37.53 million) and Spain (EUR 16.84 million) in relation to a pajor public health emergency.

The Commission already paid out advances to Croatia (EUR 88.96 million) in relation to a natural disaster.
