The present transfer proposes to reinforce the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund (AMIF) by EUR 102,3 million in commitment appropriations and EUR 95,1 million in payment appropriations. In addition, it is proposed to reinforce the Fund for emergency measures related to animal and plant health by EUR 12,6 million in payment appropriations.

The corresponding appropriations are made available by the Third programme for the Union's actions in the field of health (2014-2020), the European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control, the European Food Safety Authority, the European Medicines Agency, the European Border and Coast Guard Agency (Frontex), the European Union Agency for Law Enforcement Training (CEPOL) and by the European Agency for the operational management of large-scale IT systems in the area of freedom, security and justice (eu-LISA).

The budget line was reinforced early April by an autonomous transfer from chapter 17 04 - Food and feed safety, animal health, animal welfare and plant health, with the intention to cover urgent Covid-19 related measures at a moment when the Emergency Support Instrument (ESI) was not yet operational. These measures were eventually financed under ESI, as soon as it became operational. Therefore, an amount of EUR 17,8 million in commitment appropriations and EUR 23,2 million in payment appropriations can be made available.

As a result, most of the planned technical work, not related to Covid-19, could not be pursued. In addition, the counterparts at Member State level were similarly engaged nationally and hence unavailable for planned collaborative work that would normally consume resources. Therefore, an amount of EUR 1,7 million in commitment and payment appropriations can be made available.

d) Detailed grounds for the increase

The proposed increase of EUR 102,3 million in commitment appropriations for the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund (AMIF) will reinforce the envelope for emergency assistance:

Needs remain considerable in the short-term, especially in Greece under continued increased pressure. Therefore, in the transition from the current to the next Multiannual Financial Framework, it is vital to ensure continued capacity to respond swiftly in case the migratory situation requires triggering emergency assistance. Furthermore, in case the next generation of programmes will not be adopted by January 2021, while Emergency Assistance will be required, it is vital to ensure the transition period and avoid an immediate collapse of Emergency Assistance support schemes in the first part of 2021.

The proposed increase of EUR 95,1 million in payment appropriations for AMIF will cover the pre-financing payments on emergency assistance files, mainly for Greece:

The contracting with Greece is expected to gather pace in the last quarter of 2020 as well as disbursement of corresponding pre-financings. Large pre-financing payments are expected inter alia on ESTIA 2020 (accommodation and cash assistance to asylum seekers and refugees), on SMS 2020 (management of all long-term accommodation sites), on grants for construction of multi-purpose reception centres on Leros, Samos and Kos, and for promoting the integration of beneficiaries of international protection in Greece.
