1. Adoption of the agenda

The agenda as set out in CM 4507/1 REV 1 was adopted.

2. Information from the Presidency

3. Enforcement in export control of dual use items – current situation and future challenges

Delegations held a discussion on the enforcement in export control of dual use items.

4. Recast of EU Regulation on Dual-Use goods (428/2009)

Delegations discussed the recast of the Regulation on Dual-Use goods, particularly the proposed Enforcement Control Mechanism.

5. Conclusions of the joint meeting

The Presidency thanked delegations for their input and active participation which will be of great value for the future work in the area of export control of Dual-Use Goods. The two Working Parties will continue their cooperation.
