THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 315/93 of 8 February 1993 laying down Community procedures for contaminants in food¹, and in particular Article 2(3) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) The Bulgarian, Croatian and Lithuanian language versions of Commission Regulation (EC) No 124/2009² contain an error in the Annex, in the header of the third column of the table, as regards the maximum content of substances in foodstuffs.
- (2) The Bulgarian, Croatian and Lithuanian language versions of Regulation (EC) No 124/2009 should therefore be corrected accordingly. The other language versions are not affected.
- (3) The measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Standing Committee on Plants, Animals, Food and Feed,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

This Regulation shall enter into force on the twentieth day following that of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
