Subject:	Proposal for a COUNCIL REGULATION establishing a dedicated financial programme for decommissioning of nuclear facilities and management of radioactive waste, and repealing Council Regulation (Euratom) No 1368/2013 - Endorsement

1. On 13 June 2018, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Council Regulation establishing a dedicated financial programme for decommissioning of nuclear facilities and management of radioactive waste, and repealing Council Regulation (Euratom) No 1368/2013.
2. The Atomic Questions Working Party had discussed the proposal and reached a provisional agreement at its level following an informal written consultation, ending on 3 November 2020, with no delegations raising objections.
3. The special meeting of the European Council of 17-21 July 2020 adopted European Council conclusions covering also the revenue for the MFF 2021-2027<sup>1</sup> including the budget for this programme.

4. The European Parliament was initially consulted in July 2018 and gave its opinion on 16 January 2019. Since then, the provisional agreement reached at the level of the Atomic Questions Working Party has substantially amended the Commission's proposal. Therefore, the European Parliament was consulted again in November 2020 and has decided not to give another opinion.
5. The text as set out in document ST 13363/20 has not been changed since the informal written consultation in Atomic Questions Working Party. The wording of Recital 24 was updated so as to reflect the latest agreement on the MFF negotiations.
6. Following horizontal agreement on the MFF and possible need for minor alignment of the text to the new MFF provisions and the lawyer-linguist revision, the text of this Council regulation will be submitted to Coreper and Council for final adoption.
7. In view of the above, the Permanent Representatives Committee is invited to:
  - confirm its agreement on the text of the Council Regulation establishing a dedicated financial programme for decommissioning of nuclear facilities and management of radioactive waste, and repealing Council Regulation (Euratom) No 1368/2013 as set out in document ST 13363/20.
